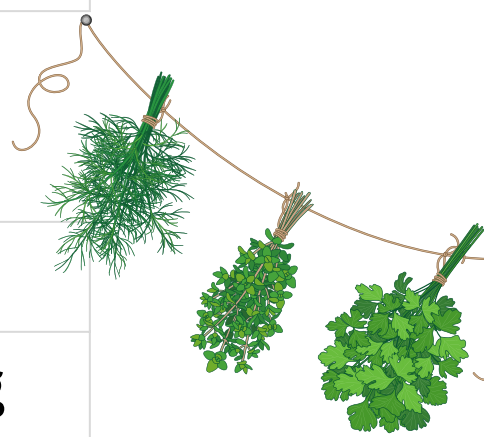

3	Squash	One or more single or mixed variety squash
4	Herb	A spray of herbs in a container (min 3)
5	Funniest Shaped Vegetable	An amusing shaped vegetable
6	Soft Fruit	5 soft fruits on a plate
7	Any Other Fruit	A display of any other fruits on a tray

8	Floral Display	A selection homegrown flowers in a jug or vase
9	A Perfect Stem	One single stem of homegrown flower

10	Any Cake	Using Fairtrade products where possible make a cake of your choice.. Please bring a piece of paper with name and contact on one side and on the other the details of what Fairtrade products you used and why.





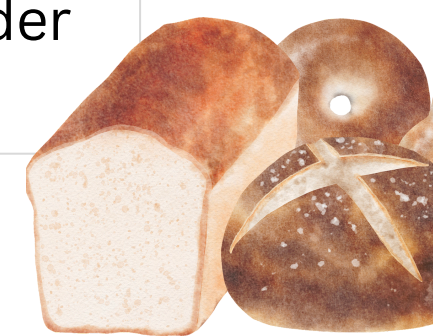

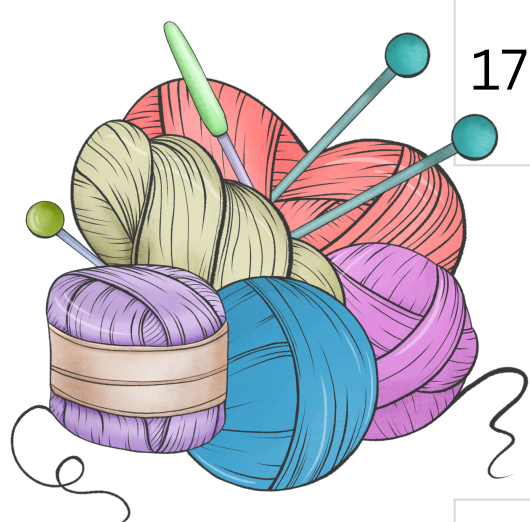

11	Jams, Jellies & Chutneys	One jar of any variety Jam, Jelly or Chutney
12	Bakery	One loaf or 3 buns of bread utilising fruits or vegetables
13	Cheers!	A bottle of Homemade Beer, Wine Cider or Other



Class	Arts & Crafts Class	Description
14	A Handicraft Item	A papercraft, woodwork or jewellery item
15	A Fabric Craft Item	A sewing, patchwork or embroidery piece of art
16	A Yarn Craft Item	A Knitted, Crochet, Weaving, macrame or felting piece of art
17	A Drawing, Painting or Mixed Media Art Piece	Any drawing, painting or mixed media art piece

18	Fruit Vegetable or Floral Animal	Make an animal from vegetables, fruit or flowers
19	Arts & Crafts	Make a shoebox garden from natural or craft items

- Please clean and prep the entry before coming to the Town Hall. Once at the Town Hall, items are to be left on display with the corresponding label that we will provide.
- If you are entering any Cake Class, please remember to write your name and contact information on one side of a piece of paper and any Fairtrade ingredients used on the other side with a reason.
- The hall will open to the Public from 12.30 pm to 2.30 pm with prizegiving at 2.00 pm.
- The judges decisions are final.
